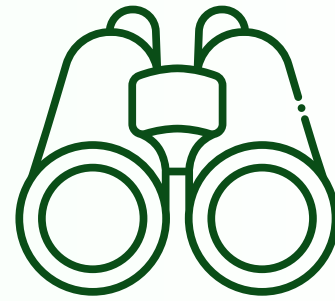

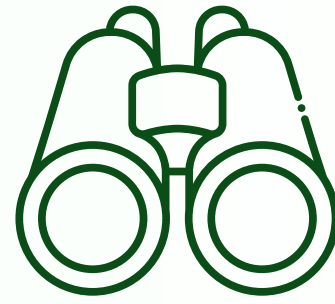
Future Outlook & Scalability
